

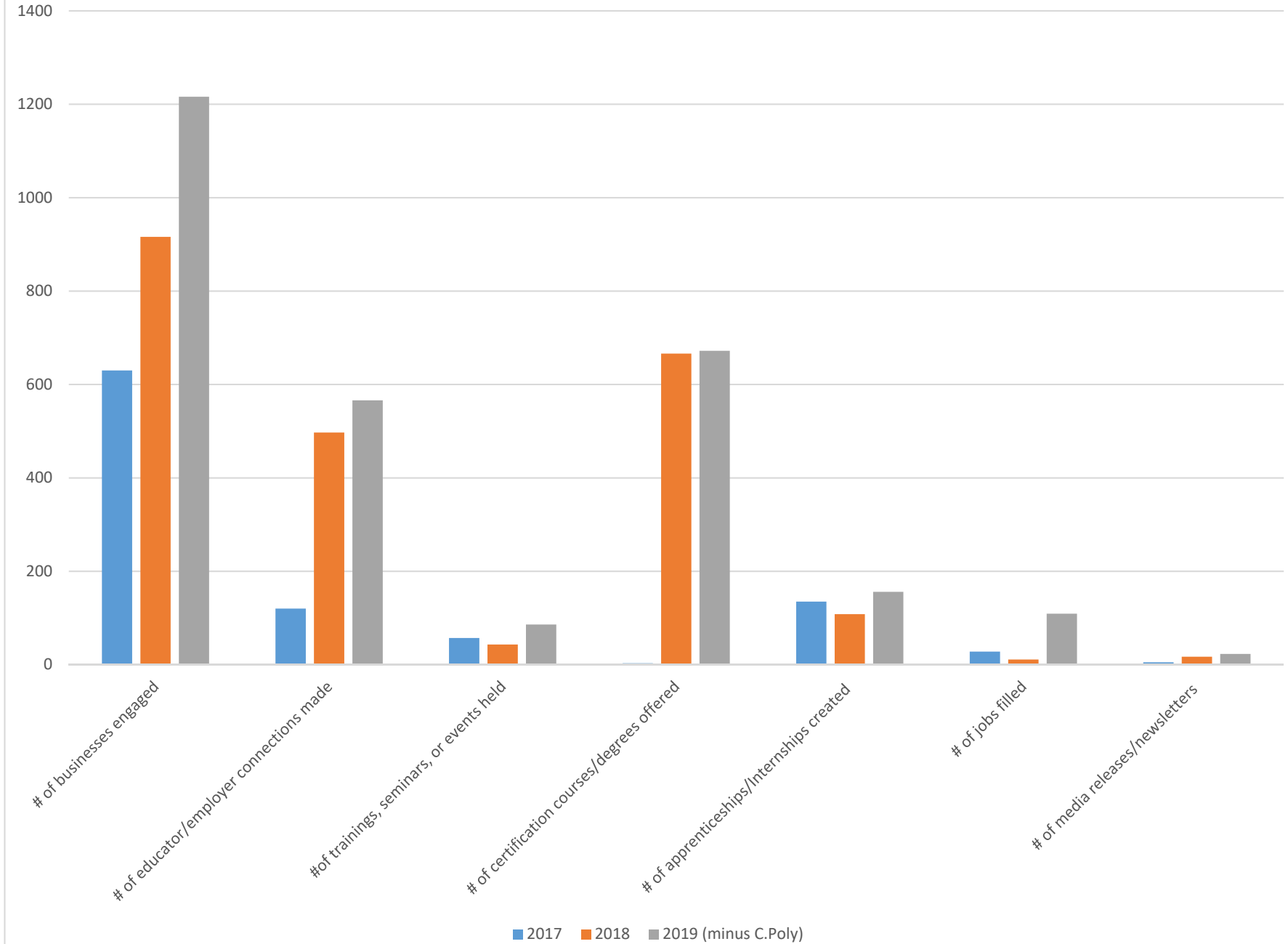

1. **# of businesses you engaged with (internships, hires, partnerships, sponsors) in 2019.** How many businesses partners did you add from 2018 (if available)?

EVC: 309 Total = 264 + 45 new businesses

COE: 197 NEW businesses

WDB: 523 employers engaged to date (received a total of 1,525 services that would qualify as a WIOA business service)

Cal Poly: 1,213 employers attended Cal Poly career fairs

Cuesta: 187 Total = 91 + 96 new employers engaged through internships and other partnerships with job fairs and recruitment events.

2. **# of educator/employer connections made in 2019.** How many additional connections did you add/make from 2018 (if available)?

EVC: n/a – any EVC connections made will be reflected in our Task Force partner's numbers (via industry cluster meetings, EVC board meetings, events)

COE: 197 businesses connected with this education org

WDB: 523 employers engaged to date (received a total of 1,525 services that would qualify as a WIOA business service)

Cal Poly: 5,200 new companies engaged with and signed up on Mustangjobs.com

Cuesta: 369 total = 346 + 23 new employers were engaged (these numbers include our Work Experience courses)

EVC: 2 (Summit & Cybersecurity)

COE: 8 TOTAL = Seminars: 3 Trainings: 4 (Software Testing, Software Development (2 courses), Precision Manufacturing, C# .Net)

WDB: 65 individuals were provided a WIOA funded training service during this report period.

**COE:** 67 Apprentices placed HIRED by partner employers in jobs / Plus 17 new Apprentices currently seeking jobs = 84 total

**WDB:** 9 apprenticeships and 32 Internship placements were provided through WIOA this reporting period 32 Internship placements were provided through

**Cal Poly:** 10,086

**Cuesta:** 46 job placements through various work study programs for students only which end when the student is no longer enrolled at Cuesta.
